

## 2017-2018 JA British Columbia Awards & Scholarships

JABC is pleased to offer a number of awards and scholarships to recognize outstanding performance in a JA program. We are able to give away **over \$20,000 worth of awards and trips** each year, thanks to the generosity of our donors and supporters.

### Individual Awards

- **JABC Student Awards for Oratory and Presentation Skills**

Oratory and presentation skills are keys to success in business and community leadership. This award recognizes achievement in the development of speaking and presentation skill and is open to any senior-secondary or post-secondary student who has participated in a JABC program within the past 5 years. Up to four (4) students will be awarded **\$2,500** each, to further their post-secondary education. Award winners present their speeches at the annual Business Laureates of British Columbia Hall of Fame Induction Gala and Ceremonies **May 8, 2018**.

*Open to JA students in Metro Vancouver and the Fraser Valley only.*

- **Dr. Donald Rix Inspiring Business Excellence Scholarship**

This award recognizes a **self-identifying Indigenous OR rural (outside Metro Vancouver, Fraser Valley and Greater Victoria) OR new immigrant student (born outside Canada)** who has demonstrated significant growth in business skills, learning skills, leadership skills and/or entrepreneurial skills. The winning student will receive a **\$2,500** scholarship towards post-secondary education.

- **JABC Award for Excellence and Leadership**

This award recognizes achievement in the development of effective personal and business management skills. The winner of the Excellence and Leadership Award will receive **\$2500** to further their post-secondary education.

- **Jan Bell-Irving Award for Women's Leadership**

This award's purpose is to **inspire and encourage young women to lead at the highest levels, with heart**. It recognizes a **female Junior Achiever** who demonstrates **the ambition to lead** and the ability to do so with **collaboration** and **kindness**. The winner of the Jan Bell-Irving Award for Women's Leadership will receive **\$2500** to further their post-secondary education.

- **The Keg Spirit Foundation Next Generation Leaders Forum Award**

This award recognizes significant progress made by individual students in developing networking and communication skills. Up to **five (5)** recipients representing each region in BC will receive this award to attend the Next Generation Leaders Forum, JA Canada's international student conference held annually in August.

- **CIBC Student Company of the Year Award – Metro Vancouver and Fraser Valley**

This award recognizes excellence in teamwork and cooperation, and outstanding planning and operation of a Student Company in Metro Vancouver and the Fraser Valley. The winning Student Company will receive an award of **\$3,000** for the team.

- **The Ledcor Group Regional Company of the Year Award**

This award recognizes excellence in teamwork and cooperation, and outstanding planning and operation of a JA Student Company outside of Metro Vancouver and the Fraser Valley in British Columbia. The winning team Student Company will receive an award of **\$3,000** for the team.

- **Celebrate Entrepreneurship Provincial Award (Innovation)**

This award recognizes the Student Company that demonstrates the most innovation in their business. Innovative products, services or business models will be judged by a panel of experts. The winning Student Company will receive an award of **\$3,000** for the team.

- **CPA Profit Performance Provincial Award**

This award will go to the most profitable student company. Profit will be determined using a standardized form which calculates gross revenues less cost of goods sold (before salaries, bonuses, dividends and charitable donations are paid) and determines the company that has generated the highest profit through their student venture. The winning Student Company will receive an award of **\$3,000** for the team.
